Friday Commodities


For a limited time, we are being gifted with commodities from First United Methodist Church that include the following: eggs, milk, bread, and fruit (last Friday we received strawberries and bananas).

We do not know what time they will arrive with these items. Last Friday they arrived in the morning. If you are interested in receiving one of these items, check at the front office to see if they have arrived. Please do not call the front office to find out, as we are currently collecting rent and need to save our phone lines for essential questions about rent and urgent matters.

Please think about which item you need the most as we are limiting the commodities to one item per resident. If you have an urgent need for more than one item, check with Lori at the end of the business day (4 PM). If there are any items left she will let you have another.

We are also still receiving food boxes from Clark County Food bank for our residents. If you would like to be on food list or wish to be taken off it, please speak to Millissia at the front office. If you receive an item in the food box that you cannot use, please do not bring the item down to the front office. You must find someone else who can use it. Do not leave food items in our common areas. If there are several items in the box that you cannot use, it is time to be removed from the food distribution list.

For any other needs you may have you are welcome to contact your resident board or floor representatives. Our resident board is in communication with management about the needs of our residents. For emergency needs you can always call the front office.
