### **Applesauce Oatmeal Bites**

Another great recipe for using up food pantry supplies. This one is a mix-and-match with whatever you have in your cupboard or have a taste for.



Preheat oven to 350 degrees and line a square baking pan with parchment paper, or spray with cooking oil.

## **Ingredients:**

1 Cup Applesauce

2 cups rolled oats

**Optional Additions: (mix and match whatever you like)** 

1/4 cup raisins or dried cranberries

1 smashed ripe banana

1 fresh peeled and diced apple

1/4 cup chopped walnuts

1/4 cup chocolate chips

1/4 cup slivered almonds

Dash of cinnamon, nutmeg, or apple pie spice

Stevia to taste

Combine oats and applesauce in a medium bowl, mix until evenly moistened. Add any optional add-ins. (Another option: sprinkle top with cinnamon sugar.

Spread mixture into prepared baking dish

Bake until no longer sticky, about 10 minutes. Some reviewers suggested to bake it an additional 5-10 minutes for a firmer texture. Flip baked oat mixture onto a work surface. Cut into bite-sized squares and allow to cool.

Store in your refrigerator, not your cookie jar. These are very moist, and will mold quickly in your cookie jar.

You can substitute any fruit puree for applesauce. Let me know if you come up with any delicious combinations!
