Nail Trims for Cats and Dogs:



KOPRC is happy to partner with certified vet tech Rebekah To offer nail trims for your cat or dog once a month in apartment 528. The service will be offered the first Tuesday of every month (July 2nd this month) at 10 AM. Please sign up at the concierge desk and begin making arrangements to secure (or borrow) a carrier for your cat. When you sign up, please pick up one packet per pet located by the sign up sheet and complete it before your appointment. The vet tech will be contacting you for the time of your appointment, please do not just show up as we do not want a lot of cats and dogs congregating together. She will accept cash only. The fee for her services is the following:

\$15 nail trim

\$25 nail trim with Dremel (dogs only)

\$35 nail trim and soft paw application (cats only)

Please bring your pet's favorite treats! Pets may need to be muzzled for safety. All cats must be in carriers. A loner carrier is available upon request, but it would be helpful for the vet tech if you make arrangements to borrow or purchase a carrier prior to your appointment.

Friday Movie List

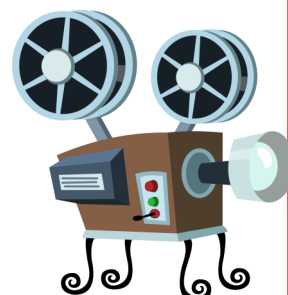
Please join us every Friday at 3 PM in the upper living room for a movie and snacks. We will be showing musicals this month:
